The difference between carbine m/1894 and carbine m/1894-14 is that there are hilts for bayonet on m/1894-14. The carbine was used primarily by the cavalry, the engineers, logistic Corps, the navy and the fortification. Today the carbine is used only by the mounted Royal Guard and at ceremonies.
